Classroom expectations/Rules

Homework/Projects/Tests/Quizzes

- All classwork, group work, homework, and projects are to be handed in on time.
- Any plagiarism, copying of another student's work will result in a failing grade.
- If any homework, project, are late, a point will be taken off for every day it is late; If it is not handed in by the end of the week, students will receive a zero.
- If a student needs extra time for a homework assignment or a project, they should email me through the gradebook wizard or come to me during a small group. They should not come to me the day an assignment is due asking for more time. I am very understanding and aware that things happen.
- 3 missing homework assignments will result in a lunch detention, the fourth will result in an after school detention
- If a student is caught doing homework during homeroom or in another class, they and whomever they are copying off will receive a lunch detention
- A quiz will be given at the end of every lesson
- Tests and quizzes are expected to be made up the day of or day after he or she returns to school. If you are absent for a long period of time we will work out a make up test date.
- Small group will require additional worksheets and or other resources for extra practice on the current topic done that week or specific areas he or she needs extra help in
- Benchmarks, performance task, and progress monitoring assessments will be given throughout each topic to ensure students are understanding the content before moving on to the next topic
- All work is graded to ensure we are following along, staying on task and understanding the content
