GOAL: To write complete sentences and stories.

Use the following lined pages and writing prompts to practice writing sentences and stories. When writing, always remember:

- o finger space(s) between words
- o proper capitalization in the beginning of sentences
- o punctuation at the end of sentences
- o sounding out words (phonetic spelling)
- o a detailed picture that matches your words

TIP: Have your student re-read their story a day after writing it.

Have them change or add to their words or picture if they would like. When they're finished, have them read it to you and "publish" it in a special place in your house (hang on the refrigerator, in their bedroom, etc.)!
