

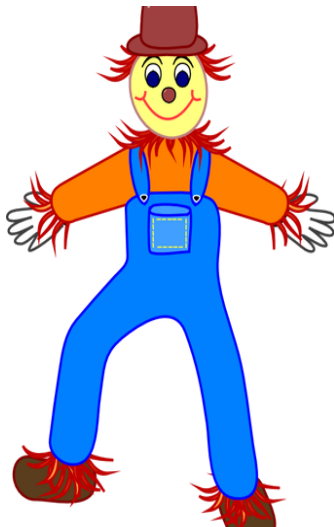

Arrival/Dismissal

Stop and Drop!

Arrival-Families are to line up in the front of the school building where students will exit the car to enter the building. Faculty will be outside to greet them. **Please do not park or get out of the car.** Students dropped off from 8:30 - 8:50 am may go directly to class. After 8:50 am, students will ring the doorbell and receive a late pass from the school office.

Students may not exit the car before the door is open.

Dismissal - Families are to line up in the front of the building and their child will be called out and escorted to the car. Parent Pick-Up starts at 3:15 pm, after school buses are dismissed. (11:35 am on half days) Please DO NOT park or exit the car. This holds up the line, creating traffic and safety issues.
